1. CALL TO ORDER
The meeting was called to order by Bill Florea at 9:00 a.m.
2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA - Agenda items were approved.
3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING- February minutes need to be revised to change "Jim" to "Tim". The minutes were then approved as amended.
4. AGENDA ITEMS

 - Fall 2016 Hinkson and Bonne Femme Habitat Assessment Scores
 - Cody and David gave an overview of the process for scoring. There is a distinct difference between the upstream and downstream segments. The scores help eliminate habitat as a reason for impairment so it is most likely a water quality issue. However, this is a broad brush method.
 - Riparian Subcommittee
 - Kori provided the following update:
 - John Mehys with the City provided an update on the El Chaparral Site.
 - Mike Powell mentioned possible funding through the USDA RCPP program and stated that he would be interested in helping with any applications.
 - Paul Land stated that he would like to see the Riparian Subcommittee look in to stormwater mitigation banking in regards to the City's redevelopment rules. Mike Powell volunteered to help look in to this item. Overland Park was given as an example.
 - Frank Gordon was able to attend the meeting.
 - Actions Process Subcommittee
 - Cody and Jennifer met and discussed the latest science and riparian stream reclassification.
